

SOCIO-ECONOMIC CONDITIONS OF DWELLERS IN OHNDAW VILLAGE, SAGAING TOWNSHIP

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Abstract

This paper examines socio-economic conditions of dwellers in Ohndaw village, Sagaing Township.). Ohndaw village, in Sagaing township, is remarkable developed and expanded the village area, located on the express-way of Mandalay-Sagaing- to Monywa and Shwebo. Besides, The Nationalities Youth Resource Development Degree College (NYRDDC) was established at the vicinity of Ohndaw village in 2014. Being located the vicinity of NYRDDC and on the high-way of Mandalay-Sagaing to Monywa and Shwebo, and area of break-of-bulk point, the village seems rapidly growth and develops socio-economic conditions. To verify this condition, we observed socio-economic factors of the dwellers in village such as gender, ethnic, religion, occupation, family size, education attainments, land tenure, housing type, family incomes, use of drinking water resource, health, use of latrine types, solid waste removal system, and use of cooking fuel respectively.
